Thank you for making a nomination for Senior Citizen of the Year. In making this nomination, you attest to the facts that your nominee is of good moral character, is a resident of Encinitas, is age 60+, is not an elected official or City employee and has not won this award previously.

Instructions

Candidates will be evaluated equally upon (1) the Services that they have performed and (2) the Impact of those services, based upon the documentation that you provide. The more thorough your documentation, the greater the chances your candidate will have to win. Panelists from the Encinitas Senior Citizen Commission and the Encinitas Rotary Club will review your nomination forms and rate each submission.

In considering (1), Services Performed, the panelists will consider the type (e.g., volunteerism, leadership helping, mentoring) and number of different services that were performed. They will also consider how long these services were performed and the recipients of those services. In considering (2) Impact, the panelists will consider the outcomes of those services, the number of Encinitas citizens that were affected, and any lasting effects that these services may have had.
